On Saturday August 31st, 2024 at approximately 2107 I was in uniform, displaying my badge of authority, and operating marked cruiser 838. I was dispatched to Speedway at 1102 West Main St. for the report of a female with a knife trying to take a vehicle. I was told to look for a silver Toyota Camry in the parking lot.						
I arrived on scene and did not see a Camry in the parking lot. [REDACTED] was in the parking lot with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me that the female had tried to stab him and hit him with a hammer, and that she had taken the car. I advised over the radio that it was a carjacking and the vehicle was no longer on scene. Mr. [REDACTED] told me that she almost struck him in the parking lot.						
[REDACTED] went onto explain that he saw a heavy set white female in the parking lot of Speedway wearing a green shirt, like tye dyed shirt and possibly a trashbag looking homeless. The female asked for a ride. [REDACTED] gave the female a ride and shortly into the ride the female produced a "carpenters knife" with a black handle and gold blade. The female put the knife to his throat and threatened to stab him/cut his throat. [REDACTED] came back to Speedway. The female also made statements about hitting [REDACTED] with a hammer. [REDACTED] got out of the vehicle and went inside to get help. [REDACTED] stated he was willing to prosecute and wanted the vehicle entered as stolen. I asked [REDACTED] to complete a written statement. [REDACTED] stated he had never seen the female before nor did he know her. Mr. [REDACTED] also stated that she had been making comments about how she was tired of being at the bottom and how she was going to have to cut the people at the top or cut her way to the top.						
I provided a BOLO to dispatch and asked for it to be given to surrounding agencies.						
[REDACTED] agreed to complete a written statement. [REDACTED] told me that her manager was on the way in to view security camera footage with me.						
Officer Hale told me that they had dealt with a similar female the night before and had comms send a 27 photo to our email. I showed [REDACTED] the photo and he confirmed that that was the female who took the vehicle.						
I gave [REDACTED] my business card and the case number.

NARRATIVE:

I stayed on scene to wait for the manager to view security footage.

At approximately 2150 I heard Officer Caudell markout that he was with the vehicle and attempting a felony stop at Sonic. I left Speedway to back him. I arrived at Sonic and observed the silver Camry at the entrance to the parking lot, headlights were off, and the vehicle was exiting the parking lot through the entrance of the business onto West Main St. I had the emergency lights on my cruiser activated. As I exited my vehicle I observed the female who matched the description given by the victim in the drivers seat. She appeared to be the only occupant of the vehicle. The female put the car in drive and pulled out onto West Main St. traveling Eastbound. I began following the vehicle Eastbound. The vehicle ran the redlight at West Main St. and Memorial Bridge. I confirmed that the vehicle was the one stolen from [REDACTED] The vehicle continued East on East Main St. I advised dispatch that I was in pursuit and gave the direction of travel.

The vehicle traveled at approximately 60 mph, until reaching downtown. The vehicle slowed to approximately 45 mph. The vehicle was passing traffic by going into the turn lane. In the 1000/1100 block of East Main St. the vehicle narrowly missed a pedestrian who was crossing the road. We continued past Tyler Ave. We continued East down East Main St. between 40-50 mph until reaching Jefferson St. The vehicle accelarated to roughly 60-65mph.

Acting Sergeant Torres joined the pursuit and took over radio traffic. I continued to follow the vehicle on East Main St. towards the Montgomery County line where it becomes Radford Rd. The vehicle was crossing the double yellow line multiple times, weaving back and forth.

Several Montgomery County Deputies were waiting at Triangle Mart and joined the pursuit. I continued to follow the vehicle as the primary unit in the pursuit. Speeds at this time were between roughly 65-90 mph. The vehicle continued to cross the double yellow and drive in the turn lane. At some point Officer Caudell advised us that the driver had yelled out to him that she had doused herself in gasloine and that she would blow herself/the vehicle up.

The vehicle continued down Radford Rd. towards Christiansburg. Several Christiansburg Police vehicles were waiting at the town line and I believe they had a successful spike strip deployment.

As we continued into Christiansburg I observed a black sedan in the turn lane and watched the suspect vehicle swerve into the turn lane and strike the black sedan, the black sedan left the roadway and the silver Camry continued into oncoming traffic striking a VW Beetle head on. The silver Camry came to rest facing Westbound with heavy front end damage/smoking.

I exited my cruiser and drew my service weapon giving commands for the driver to show me her hands. Due to smoke coming from the vehicle I could not easily see into it. As I approached the vehicle I could see the head of the female laying on the seat. I drew my baton and struck the windows of the vehicle breaking them. Officer Widner and I pulled her from the vehicle. She was wearing the green shirt as described and did not appear to be wearing pants or underwear. I

NARRATIVE: started feeling for a carotid pulse, if one was present it was faint. I could not feel a pulse in her wrist. I instructed Officer Widner to begin CPR. I quickly surveyed the scene and then began doing CPR on the female. I switched out with Officer Widner and then took over again a short time later. At the medics request I started ventilating the patient using a bag valve mask provided by the fire department. I assisted medcis with loading the female into the ambulance. A short time later the fire department asked if someone could drive the ambluance for them. Due to prior experience as an EMT I cleared this with A/Sgt. Torres and then advised dispatch that I was driving the Christiansburg Ambulance to the Med Center. I also advised dispatch when I arrived at the Med Center. The female was taken into room 17. Doctor Stanley declared the female deceased at 2240. I advised A/Sgt Torres of this immediately and asked for permission to turn off my body cam. I turned off my body cam and stayed with the body until relieved around 2300. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] I was advised that Virginia State Police would be handling the crash.

On August 31st, 2024 I, Officer Widner, was riding with Sgt Torres when Officer Winkeler radioed he was in an active pursuit with the stolen vehicle. Officer Winkeler remained primary with Sgt Torres marked as secondary during the pursuit. The pursuit ended when the suspect vehicle crashed into two separate vehicles at S&H Automobiles in Montgomery County. I exited the vehicle and drew my service weapon. I approached the vehicle with Officer Winkeler and assisted Officer Winkeler with extracting the offender. Officer Winkeler began to check for a pulse due to the offender being unresponsive and not breathing. Officer Winkeler instructed to begin CPR. I initiated CPR and conducted CPR for several rounds, alternating with Sgt Torres and Officer Winkeler. The offender was transported to the NRV Med Center, while Sgt Torres and I remained on-scene. for the pursuit. Us we headed East on East Main Street, I observed the fleeing vehicle nearly strike a pedestrian who was jaywalking in the area of 1100 East Main Street. The pursuit continued East passing Jefferson Street at which point it became apparent it would be leaving the City onto Montgomery County. I relayed to dispatch to notify Montgomery and Christiansburg units. I requested stop sticks be deploy due to it being a car jacking suspect. As the pursuit continued near the 100 Block of East Main Street I observed the suspect vehicle all over the road, at time traveling East on the West bound lanes. As we crossed onto Montgomery County I advised additional units stay in the City and that only Ofc. Winkeler and myself being the secondary unit would continue onto Montgomery County. The vehicle continued now on Radford Road towards Christiansburg town limits. I observed several law enforcement units near the Christiansburg Town limits and saw them pull stop sticks from the road way as the fleeing vehicle passed their location. Later found out they had a successful deployment. A few seconds after the stop sticks were deployed, I observed as the fleeing vehicle attempted to go around a vehicle that was in the center turn lane near 1255 Radford Street. The vehicle turned left at which point the suspect struck the vehicle first then its forward momentum continued and it struck a second vehicle head on. Ofc. Winkeler, Ofc. Widner who was passenger in my vehicle and I quickly attempted to apprehend the suspect. I maintained cover from the passenger side of the vehicle as Ofc. Winkeler broke the driver side window to gain entry into the vehicle and extract the offender. It was quickly noticed that the offender Khasi Chrisley was unresponsive. Immediately Ofc. Widner, Ofc. Winkeler and I began to provide CPR until medic units arrived and took over. Offender was transported to the Med Center and Ofc. Winkeler assisted with the transport. Ofc. Winkeler then contact me stating the offender was deceased at 22:40. Capt. Slaughter and Chief Holdaway were notified.
